



**Please note that awards 1,2,3,6 and 7 are for people with learning disabilities. Nominees must also live in Scotland.**

### **1. Sport achievement award**

Nominees do not need to be competing at a professional level to be eligible for an award. So long as nominees have a regular commitment to their sport and can provide examples of how success has been achieved in their chosen speciality, they are encouraged to apply.

### **2. Youth achievement award**

This award is for people who are 11-26 years old. So long as the nominee has made a positive impact and is passionate about their goals, they are eligible to apply. They might be involved in a local campaign or community group, or be making a difference at a national level.

### **3. Employee recognition award**

People with learning disabilities hold a wide range of jobs across Scotland. If you know an employee who deserves to be recognised for their valuable contribution, you can nominate them. This award is only open to those who are currently in employment. ### **4. Exceptional frontline worker award**

This award is open to anyone who provides paid support to an individual with learning disabilities. This could include privately employed frontline workers, as well as those employed through social care, health, housing, or another publicly funded service.

### **5. Inspirational family carer award**

This award is open to nominees who are providing care to a family member who has learning disabilities.

### **6. Creative achievement award**

The definition of 'creative achievement' for this award is wide ranging, and could include success in visual arts, dance, music, performance, design, sculpture, or any other endeavour which requires creative input.

### **7. RSA social impact award**

The 'RSA' is the Royal Society of Arts, Manufacturing and Commerce. Nominees for this award must be aged 18 or above. Nominations for this award, which includes receipt of a Fellowship to the RSA, will be judged in relation to the RSA mission and values, which can be found here: <https://www.thersa.org/about-us/our-mission>
