# Guidance notes

Please note this nomination is for a person(s) with a learning disability

## What is a learning disability?

A learning disability is significant and lifelong. It starts before adulthood and affects the person's development. This means that a person with a learning disability will likely need help to understand information, learn skills and have a fulfilling life. Some people with a learning disability will also have healthcare needs and require support to communicate.

## About the award

Individuals who have a learning disability have the power to express their creative and artistic talent and engage with the world, with the potential to impact the lives of others and to change attitudes in our society. There is huge creative talent in Scotland's communities and we want to hear about it. That is why we want to recognise the creative talent within Scotland's communities.

## Your nomination

### Award criteria

This award is open for nominations across all creative disciplines. Whether your nominee(s) write, dance, sing, produce visual art, act, perform music or are involved in something completely unique, we want to hear about them.

Please include the following information for the judges:

- Tell us about the skills, experience and achievements of the person or group; include examples of creative work or content
- Demonstrate sustained involvement (2-3 years) of the person or group within their chosen creative field
- Provide evidence of how the person or group is developing their artistic and creative potential or how they are aspiring to do this
- Demonstrate and evidence artistic and creative challenges or personal challenges that have been overcome
- Provide evidence of the links with the wider community that the person or group has and the difference this is making e.g. encouraging more people in the community to get involved
- Tell us about what future plans or what the next steps are for the person or group's artistic and creative journey.

## What happens next?

Once the judging process is completed, SCLD will inform the nominator of the outcome. We will contact everyone during the week beginning **25th March 2019**.
