Situationship Game Instructions







We have made a game about relationships

The game is called 'Situationships'



You can play the Situationships game in person or by doing a video call



You can print extra copies of the Situationships game from the SCLD website



The aim of the game is learning about happy and healthy relationships



These are the instructions for the game

How to play





You can play on your own or in a team

The team should have 2 to 3 people

There should be at least 2 players or 2 teams



Pick a coloured counter



Decide who will go first



Roll the dice

Read the number on the dice

This is the number on top of the dice



Move the coloured counter along the squares on the board to match the number you have rolled on the dice



Some squares on the board are called **Situationship Squares**



When you land on a **Situationship Square** you need to pick up a **Scenario Card**



You can get larger print **Scenario Cards** on SCLD website



A **Scenario Card** is a card which tells you about a **situation**



A **situation** means something that is happening or has happened



Read what the card says

You can ask someone to read it with you



All of the players should talk about what the card says

Decide together if the story on the card is



Something that is good in a relationship



Is it something that is bad in a relationship?



You might not be able to agree and that is ok



If you think what the card says is good move one square forward on the board



If you think what the card says is bad move back one square



If you all cannot decide then stay where you are



The winners are the first to reach the finish



But the aim of the game is to talk about relationships
