
About Sproutflix

This film was made in North America where they use words that we do not use here. Some of these words are offensive to us here in Scotland but are not meant to be offensive when used in this film.

WEDNESDAY Challenges

This film is called Best Interest. It was made in the United Kingdom. It was made in 2010. It is in the English language. It is 9 minutes long.

This film is about two people who have started a romantic relationship. Other people in their lives think they know what is best for them and try to keep them apart.

This film shows how people can mean well but actually hold back people with a learning disability and stop them from living their lives to the full. We are highlighting this film as part of challenges in relationships. Sometimes relationships are unable to flourish because others have got involved.

This film is about parents with learning disabilities. You might find this film upsetting in places. The film talks about both good and bad experiences of parents with learning disabilities and their children. The film talks about how supported parenting can be helpful. This is one of our family themed films.
