



## How to download Human Rights Town?



Go to the Google Play or Apple Store on your smartphone or tablet



If you have an iPhone or iPad you will need to open the Apple Store



If you have an Android phone or tablet you will need to open the Google Play store



Type human rights town into the search bar



The logo for the app should appear it has a purple background



Click on the logo



You should then be taken to a page that tells you about the human rights town app

Welcome to Human Rights Town! Everyone has rights which are protected by law, including people with learning disabilities. This app has been developed by the Scottish Commission for People with Learning Disabilities (SCLD) to help inform people with disabilities about their human rights, as set out in the United Nations Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities. Explore the town map to encounter scenarios and answer questions. Each scenario in the app has been devised with input from people with learning disabilities.



Click the button that says install

The app will now download onto your phone or tablet



### Quick guide to using the app



Explore the town by moving around the map. You can swipe with your finger, use the arrows, or press 'Go to next location'. There are zoom buttons to zoom in and out too.



1. Look for pins on the map. Touching a pin will reveal a scenario
2. Each scenario describes a situation you might come across in real life. You can read the scenario or press the speaker icon to hear it read out loud



3. Then decide if you think the situation respects the person's human rights or not
4. Select your answer and submit it



5. Afterwards you will see if you were right or not. You can also find more information about human rights on the information page.
6. There are 25 scenarios, each with a question to answer
7. Once you've finished, you can share your score on social media!
