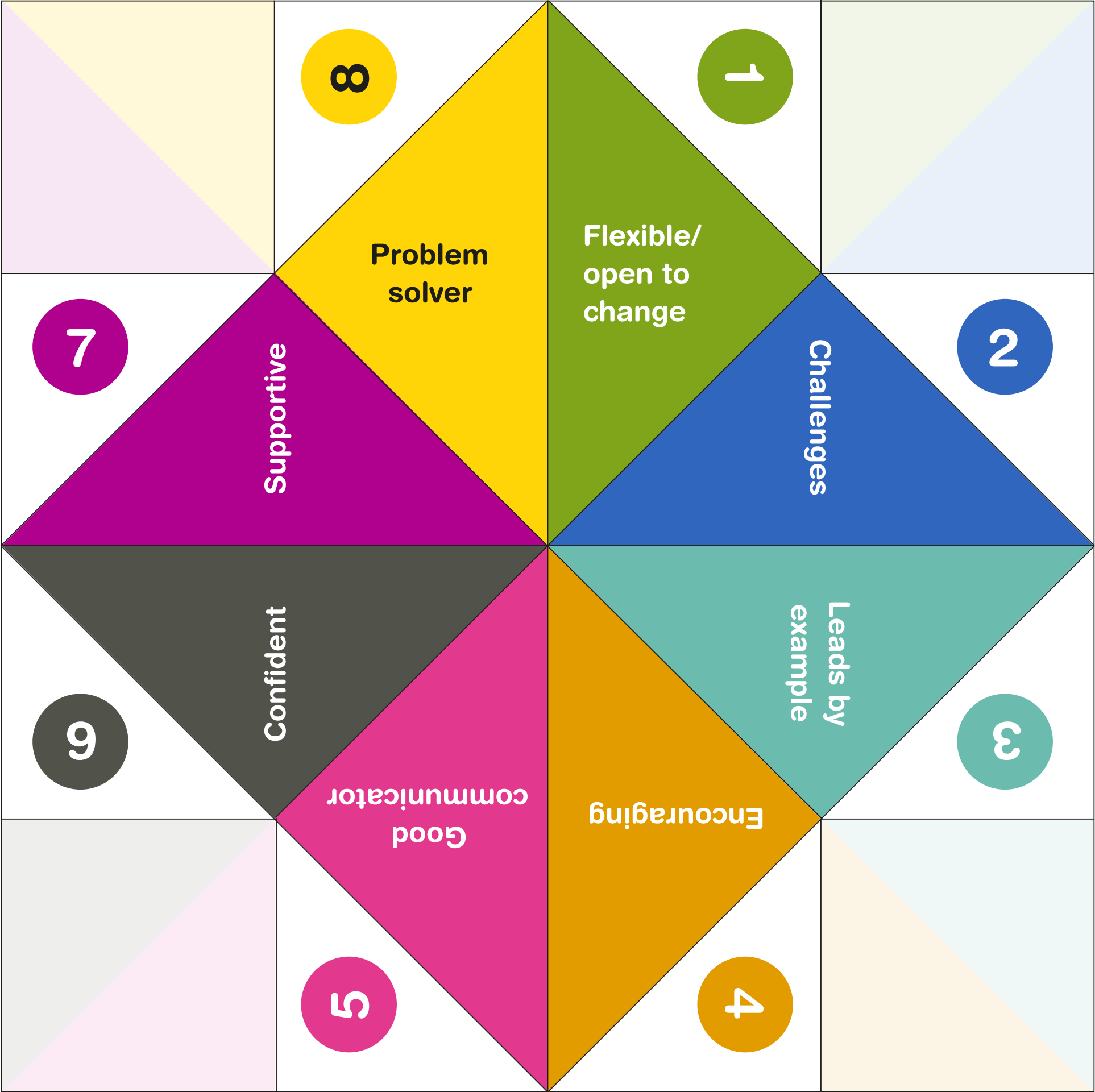


Leadership
