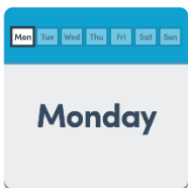




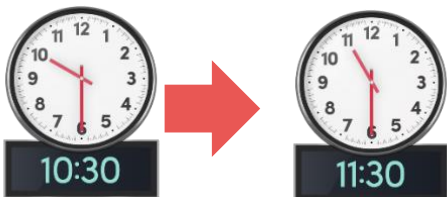

SCLD has looked at **digital technology** across health and social care for people with learning disabilities.



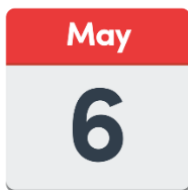
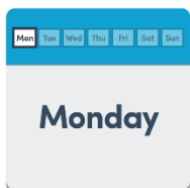

In this event you will talk about our research:

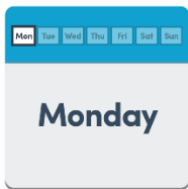

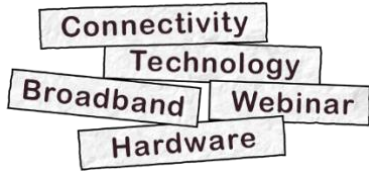
